Things to expect; weather/climate/location/etc:

- August: Mornings will typically be in the mid 40's and warm up into the 80's throughout the day. A passing afternoon shower is common
- September: Mornings will typically be in the mid 30's and warm up into the 70's throughout the day. A passing afternoon shower is common
- October: Expect mornings to be below freezing but warm up into the 60's throughout the day. Potential for snow fall.
- New Mexico Outfitter is based outside of Taos, NM; the closest international airport is Albuquerque Intl. Sunport
- Clients should expect a physically demanding hunt due to terrain and elevation which will vary from 6,200ft-10,000ft depending on the hunt location.
 Note: Due to the remoteness of some of these hunts, clients should expect spotty-no cell phone service.
- Outfitter can provide a recommended packing list by request, but at minimum should include: rain gear, day pack-water bottle+snacks+lighter+headlamp, sleeping bag, sleeping pad and/or cot, small gas stove, cooler(s) to transport meat.
- All hunts will be on National Forest and Wilderness Land and will strictly operate under the "Leave No Trace" guidelines
